Dear D12 Families,

Last evening our opening of school plan was presented to the Board of Education. It was also sent to all families late last night and is posted on our website. This letter will provide an overview of the options available to parents; however, I encourage you to watch the presentation for additional details.

Our kindergarten program will be all day, every day, in person. We will adjust class sizes to ensure that they are small enough to accommodate social distancing.

Families with students in grades one through eight will select one of two options:

Option 1: In-person instruction

Students will attend school wearing masks at all times when indoors and maintaining social distancing of six feet in all possible situations. Based on enrollment, students will either attend all day, every day or on a modified schedule of two days per week in person and three days per week remote learning.

Option 2: Remote learning

Students will participate in five hours per day of learning which will be a combination of live instruction, recorded instruction, small group instruction and independent learning activities. Remote learning will be taught by teachers assigned to that role.

Families will select from one of the two options, and this commitment will last through December 18, 2020. If our region is still in Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois plan in November, families will select from the two options for the second half of the school year. Families will not be able to change their selection at other times.

A commitment form must be completed for each child in grades one through eight. Based on individual student's needs, families are able to select in-person instruction for one or more of their children and remote learning for others. Forms are due by Friday, July 24th.
